

Directions for Syllable Activity Cards

Traditional teaching lesson

Before lesson, explain to child how words are made up of syllables. Find words in familiar books and talk about how many syllables each word has.

Demonstrate how to determine how many syllables a word has by either placing your hand under your chin to count how many times your chin goes down, or show how to tap your foot(or hand) to each syllable.

1. Print out cards and control card and laminate.

Place the syllable heading cards

in the top-center of the workspace.

Stack the word cards in a pile to the right of the workspace.

Review how to determine how many syllables a word has.

Say each word as you pick up a word card. Count the syllables in the word and then place the card under the proper column heading.



Check answers with control card when finished.
